The club tractor has gone through a big overhaul with some long overdue repairs and will be ready for the next round of trail work and the Alumni Parade.

Rail Trail: We are working closely with the City of Claremont, NH DOT and Federal Highway Department offices. A survey needs to be done to see where we can extend the trail to accommodate pedestrians, bikers and ATVs.

Trail Report:**Winter Riding:**

Our trails are open to ATVs until March 1st at the start of mud season.

Please ride when there is enough groomable snow and temperatures are below freezing (32°C). Please give groomers the right of way.

Remember if ATVs are not allowed on a specific trail in the summer then they are not allowed anytime. For example: The Claremont section of the rail trail is still closed to all motorized wheeled vehicles.

Veteran's Park Road. and Cat Hole Road that connect the Burger King Trail to the Cat Hole Trails are closed to ATVs for the winter and will re-open May 23rd.

The Sugar River Rail Trail is open year round with parking across from the storage units on Washington St. in Claremont and in Newport on Belknap Rd.

Mica Mine Trails are open until March 1st and will re-open May 23rd.

Side by Sides that are wider than 54" with tracks are illegal in NH.

Please respect landowner's property. Watch for signs. Not all snowmobile trails are open to ATVs.

Volunteers Needed: We need your help in many ways from tree work, trash pick-up, signage, club events and community service. Many hands make for light and fun work!! Contact us to let us know what you would be interested in doing. Some tasks take as little as an hour of light work and some require tools and little more elbow grease.
